In our 15 years, more than 15,370 volunteers have collectively accumulated more than 139,000 volunteer hours reading aloud to a total attendance of 119,934 children. In addition to giving a new book to every child who attends, we have given more than 23,600 books to parents and teachers and donated 21,520 hardcover books to school libraries.
